# Things to Bring on the Cabin Trip

## • Plan to dress in layers

### • Hats, gloves and socks tend to get wet, so have extras

### Warm Clothes

- 2-3 pairs of warm pants (avoid cotton pants like jeans which hold moisture)
- Long johns and regular underwear
- Shirts and sweatshirts that can be layered
- 2-4 pairs warm socks (avoid cotton)
- 1 pair of shoes and 1 pair of winter boots
- Pajamas (optional)
- Hat(s) and Gloves(s)
- Snow Pants
- Coat
- Some plastic shopping bags

**Equipment** – mark your stuff so you can identify it

- Scout Book all advancement is recorded in your book
- Mess Kit or Cup and plate
- Fork, knife and spoon
- Water Bottle
- Flashlight and spare batteries
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, etc.)
- Sleeping bag and pillow

#### Advancement Stuff

Bring the items below if you have them, if not, don't worry

- Pocketknife
- First Aid kit
- Compass

## • DO NOT BRING MATCHES, LIGHTERS, ETC.

Matches may only be carried and used if a scout has earned his Firem'n Chit. Also, a knife may only be carried and used if a scout has his Totin' Chit (which is not the same as a Whittling Chit). Scouts are asked to bring their knives as we will be working on the Totin' Chit but are not permitted to use them unless instructed to do so by a leader/older scout or have finished the Totin' Chit requirements. We will also be working on the Firem'n Chit, but matches will be provided.
